

Ethics in Public Administration international project

Multilateral meeting in Prague, February 2013

The other meeting was held in Prague in February 2013, where the further steps on particular chapters were discussed.

As far as it concerns the ethics comparison table, the outputs from project countries were delivered and presented. The chapter will be divided to national sections, which will contain the chart with national findings.

The other discussed chapter was the one focused on the research on vocational training for civil service employees in prevention of corruption. The exact structure of this chapter will be discussed at the next meeting in Lisbon in March. However, regarding the courses on prevention of corruption for civil service employees, researchers will specify the title, organization providing the course and prepare a short abstract of the course contents. Subsequently, each course will be analyzed through the evaluation questionnaire and a short conclusive summary for all courses will be provided.



The final research report will be released on CDs. They are to be produced in English as well as in national languages (the translation of the report into national language depends on each partner's consideration). The printed version (paper form) is not obligatory but just recommended. Beside CDs and paper form of the final study, partners are encouraged to upload the document on the ethics project's section of their website.

The project shall be inserted in the international database European Shared Treasure Database (www.europeansharedtreasure.eu). The text to be inserted includes the general description in English and highly recommended is to involve the description in national languages as well. Project outputs are to be uploaded to the database too.
