

Ethics in Public Administration – project's meeting

October 2012

In October 2012, representatives of project partners met on the further multilateral meeting in Warsaw. The initial part was dedicated to the presentation of the second part of the Polish chapter on teaching ethics principles to public administration employees given by Prof. Marek Kosewski and Ms. Małgorzata Skawińska (following the presentations of the first part by Dr. Roxana Zyman and Dr. Anna Jaron during the June meeting in Berlin). They presented the way they teach and do training on ethics principles for public administration employees - at KSAP and in other premises - in the form of dignity-based management.

The second part of meeting was dedicated to discussions about the structure of particular chapters. Partners concluded on the following form of the public administration involving:

- *basic information about the country*
- *structure of public administration*
- *types of employment in public administration*
- *recruitment in public administration*
- *training in public administration in general*

and the following structure of the ethics chapter:

- *definition of ethics principles for public administration employees*
- *legal forms of documents defining ethics principles to public administration employees*
- *enforcement of respecting ethics principles by public administration employees/penalties for non-respecting*

Discussions on the training in ethics chapter resulted in the idea to conduct research in partners countries focused on the supply of training courses for public administration officials. The final meeting's phase was dedicated to the approach on publication of the study.
